O.B.Paint or W.B.Paint

**GL Room and hallways on ground floor.** Are done in smooth vanilla water base paint

GL room ceiling and hall ways on ground floor are in a flat ceiling white W.B.P  
GL room doors, skirting boards, architraves, and jams, are in white oil based paint

**Old rehearsal room, come south.**

Old rehearsal room, Ceiling - Are in a flat ceiling white water base paint

Old rehearsal room, Walls- the walls are clotted cream W.B.Paint

Old rehearsal room, skirting boards, architraves, and jams, are in satin white O.B.Paint

**Kitchen.**

**Kitchen ceiling is -** flat white O.B.P

Kitchen walls - are a clotted cream O.B.P

Kitchen cupboards- are in satin white O.B.Paint

All satin white O.B.Paint have had one coat of prep under coat.

With two coats of satin white O.B.Paint to finish.
